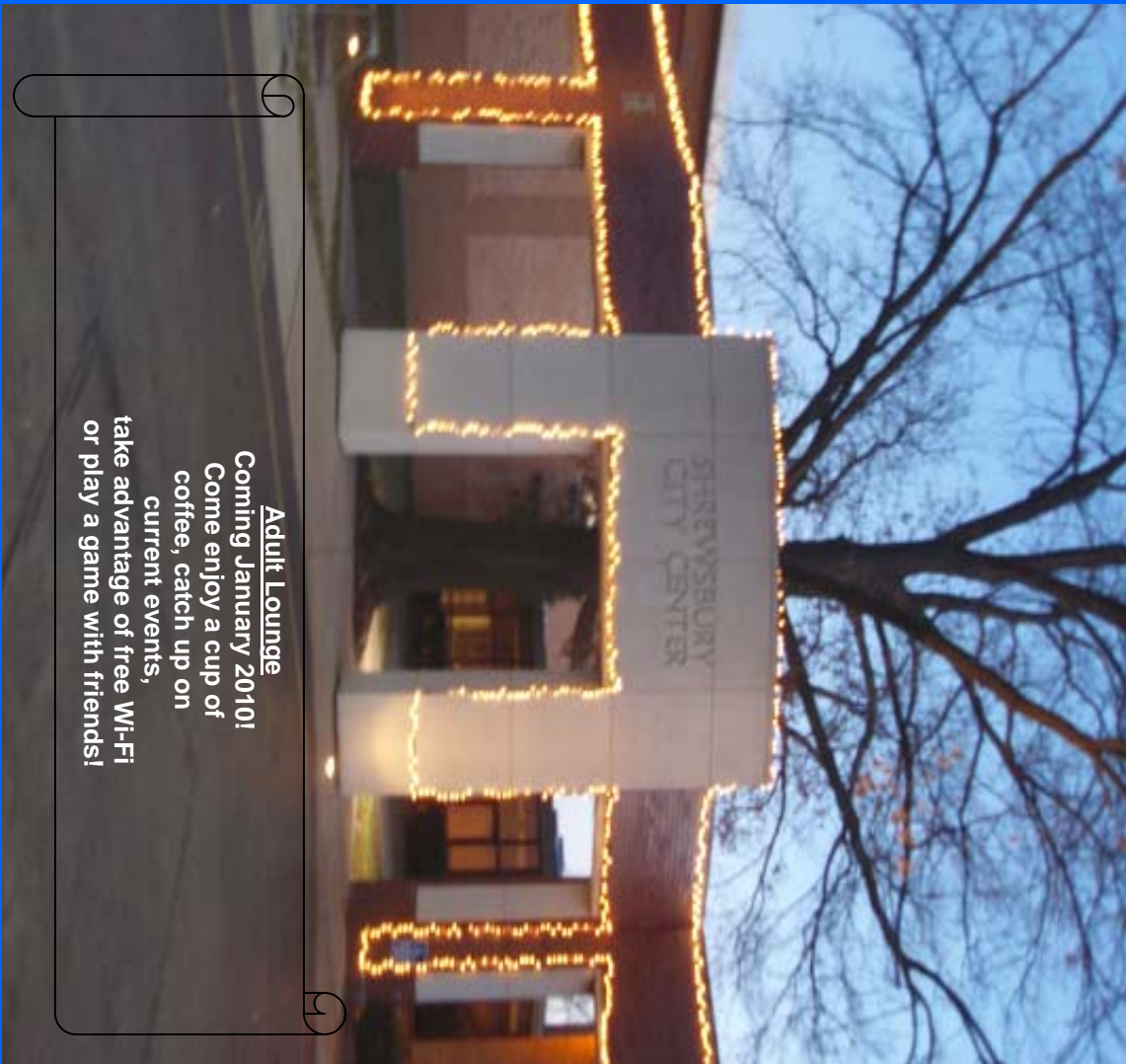

Guest of members must be accompanied by a pass holder at all times. The fee for each guest 14 years and under is \$2. The fee for each guest 15 years and up is \$3.

Aquatic Center ID Cards

Park Rentals

Water for restrooms and drinking fountains is typically turned on the beginning of April and turned off the end of October, weather permitting. Pavilions may be rented from March - October. We will begin taking reservations for 2010 on Monday February 1st.

Ackfeld Park

Ackfeld Park consists of a total of 6.8 acres of land. It is located at the intersection of Shrewsbury Avenue and Sutherland Avenue, behind the Police and Fire Station. The park has a ball field and two tennis courts. A sand volleyball court is located east of the aquatic center parking lot. This park does not have a pavilion to rent.

Brinkop
