#### Super Rec Pass (residents only)

This pass includes the use of the gym during open play, the weight room (must be at least 14 years of age), the game room, and admission to the Shrewsbury Family Aquatic Center. Passes are valid for one year from the date of purchase.

#### City Center Age Restrictions

Children ages 9 years and younger must be directly supervised by a person 13 years or older. Youth ages 10-17 may use the weight room with direct adult supervision. Youth ages 14-17 wanting to use the weight room with out adult supervision must first take the weight room workshop.

#### City Center Guest Policies

Guest of members must be accompanied by a pass holder at all times. The fee for each guest 14 years and under is \$2. The fee for each guest 15 years and up is \$3.

#### Resident Pass Requirements

All persons wishing to purchase a pass at the resident rate must be listed on the occupancy permit at their current residence.

#### Aquatic Center ID Cards

Identification cards are required for residents ages 3 and older to enter the Shrewsbury Family Aquatic Center at a Daily rate of \$4 for adults and \$3 for children. These ID's are \$10 and may be purchased at the City Center Front Desk.

#### Silver Aquatic Center Pass

Admissions to the Shrewsbury Family Aquatic Center for senior citizen residents is free for life.

#### Pool Pass

This pass includes unlimited admission to the Shrewsbury Family Aquatic Center for the entire pool season

#### Non-Resident Pool Pass

All non-residents wishing to purchase a pool pass MUST be sponsored by a Shrewsbury Resident with valid resident pass. Non-resident pass quantities are limited, so please arrange your sponsorship early to ensure your ability to purchase one.

#### Nanny Pass

This allows both resident and non-resident families to add a nanny/babysitter to their pass for a fee of \$100.

## Registration

Participants must pre-register for programs. Registration should be completed at least one week prior to the program start date. Any programs that does not meet minimum participation requirements will be cancelled three days prior to the start date. Therefore, early registration is strongly encouraged. All fees associated with any programs must be paid for at time of pre-registration.

## Refund Policy

Refunds will only be given if:

1. The participant is unable to attend due to illness. A physician's statement must be presented before a refund will be disbursed. A prorated amount will be given if the program has already begun.
2. The program is cancelled. Refunds will be given to all paid participants.
3. The participant makes a written request before the start of the second class. Request received after the second class will entitle the participant to a prorated refund at the director's discretion.

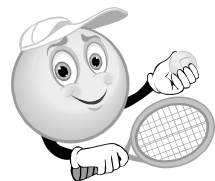

### Ackfeld Park

Ackfeld Park consists of a total of 6.8 acres of land. It is located at the intersection of Shrewsbury Avenue and Sutherland Avenue, behind the Police and Fire Station. The park has a ballfield and two tennis courts. A sand volleyball court is located east of the aquatic center parking lot.

### Brinkop

Brinkop Park's 3.4 acres are nestled in a beautiful residential area west of the intersection at Nottingham and Laurella. A new playground and walking trail was installed in 2000. The park also has a ballfield, multi-purpose court, pavilion, and restroom facility.

### Harty Park

Harty Park is the smallest park located in the City of Shrewsbury. The park is one acre of pure enjoyment and is located at 4100 Exeter Avenue. There is a newer playground and a multi-purpose court for all to use.

### Wehner Park

Wehner Park is Shrewsbury's largest park consisting of 31.8 acres. This park contains three ballfields, one soccer field, two pavilions, two playgrounds, and two tennis courts. Wehner Pavilion is located at 7600 Hazel Avenue, and the Festival Site Pavilion is located at 5200 Lenox Avenue. Wehner Park is a great place for all ages to enjoy!
