The City of Shrewsbury is committed to providing its residents with a high quality of life. As part of this commitment, the City seeks to take advantage of every opportunity to keep the city clean and beautiful. One such recent opportunity, the issuance of a St. Louis County grant, has enabled Shrewsbury to provide to you this recycling cart in order to assist you with your recycling efforts. This opportunity coincides with an increase in the number of requests from Shrewsbury residents to have larger recycling capacity that a larger cart would provide.

Your recycling will continue to be picked up each Friday in a single stream format. This means that you can combine all of your recyclable material into this cart. A list of acceptable recycling material includes the following:

Paper:-

- Newspaper, Including Inserts (remove plastic sleeves)
- Cardboard
- Brown Bags
- Magazines, Catalogs and Telephone Books
- Office, Computer, and Notebook Paper
- Chipboard (cereal and gift boxes)
- Carrier Stock (soda/beer can carrying cases)
- Mail and Junk Mail with Envelopes (remove stamps)
- Paperback Books (no hardcover books)
- Gift Wrapping Paper

Plastic:

- Soda and Water Bottles
- Milk and Juice Jugs (clear)

- Detergent and Fabric Softener Containers (colored)
- Health and Beauty Aid Products, Household Cleaners (narrow neck containers only)
- Grocery Containers (margarine tubs, frozen dessert cups)
- Plastic Buckets (5 gallon maximum size)

Additional Materials:

- Aluminum Cans, Trays and Foil (must be cleaned)
- Milk and Juice Cartons
- Steel Cans and Tins (including aerosol cans)
- Glass Bottles and Jars (clear, brown, and green)
- NO Window Glass, Dinnerware, or Ceramics
