

Roll Call

Mayor Scherer called the meeting to order, and Director Greever commenced with the roll call. A quorum was present for the transaction of city business.

Approval of Minutes

Mayor Scherer introduced the minutes from the February 4th Regular Board Meeting and opened the floor for discussion. There being no discussion, Alderman Travaglini made a motion to approve the minutes; Alderman Odenwald seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Edge Fitness Signage

Mayor Scherer introduced the next item, which was review of temporary signage for the pre-sale and interview location that they would be using until the Edge Fitness facility was ready to be used in last April. Alderman Peters made a motion for approval. Alderman Lauter seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Bio-Life Signage

Mayor Scherer introduced the next item, a temporary sign for Bio-Life. Alderman Travaglini made a motion to approve the signage. The motion was seconded by Alderman Reeves and passed unanimously by voice vote.

Purchase Requests

Parks Director Buck presented the bid results and made a purchase request for pool grates, and recommended the Board accept the bid from Capri Pools & Aquatics for \$19,950.00 as the best bid. Alderman Travaglini made a motion to approve this bid in this amount for the pool grates. Alderman Reeves seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Parks Director Buck then presented the bid results and made a purchase request for field maintenance for Fields 1 & 2. He recommended the bid from Tru Green for \$6,696.92 as the best bid. Alderman Odenwald made a motion to this effect. Alderman Peters seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Public Works Director Wagner presented the bid results and made a purchase request for commercial mowers (2 units). He recommended the Board select the bid from Mordt Tractor in the amount of \$42,357.42 as the best bid. Alderman Lauter made a motion to approve the bid. Alderman Odenwald seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Distracted Driving Ordinance

Then the Board discussed a distracted driver ordinance, which would sharpen the current distracted driver ordinance in the code book, making it more definitive, giving examples of qualifying types of distracted driving, and explicitly reinforcing the state's statutory provisions regarding the same.

The Board was generally in favor of moving forward on this matter.

Old & New Business

Alderman Reeves wished to discuss the pit bull ban ordinance at future meetings, with an eye towards removal of the ban, and replacing it with an aggressive dog ordinance. The Board was generally in favor of moving forward accordingly and will consider the matter again at the next work session.

Police Chief Vargas provided a quick update on the CALEA process, and Public Works Director Wagner provided a quick update on a recent equipment failure (the Mack truck) and his plan going forward for replacement of it.


Hear citizens
