

**Roll Call**

Mayor Scherer called the meeting to order, and Director Greever commenced with the roll call. A quorum was present for the transaction of city business.

**Bill No. 2998 – A Bill Updating the Shrewsbury Municipal Code – Special Use Permit Consideration for Passage**

The Mayor reintroduced Bill No. 2998, which had been read by title only pursuant to Missouri Statute in two previous board meetings, to receive an additional second and final reading, to ensure that the public had every opportunity to know what the Board was considering. This bill updated the Special Use Permit process of the Shrewsbury Municipal Code.

Alderman Travaglini made a motion to read the bill by title only the second and final time, again, in accordance with Missouri Statutes. Alderman Odenwald seconded the motion and it was approved by the Board. The bill was then read by title only by Attorney Daming.

Alderman Travaglini then made a motion to approve the bill. The motion was seconded by Alderman Odenwald and the following roll call vote was recorded: Alderman Travaglini “Aye”; Alderman Gorman “Aye”; Alderman Lauter “Aye”; Alderman Peters “Aye”; Alderman Odenwald “Aye”; Alderman Reeves “Aye”. Bill No. 2998 was therefore passed as Shrewsbury Ordinance No. 2985.

**Discussion on Summer Planning – Ongoing Operations, including the Parks Programs and Policing Updates**

Parks Director Buck and Police Chief Vargas provided updates from their respective departments regarding summer camp operations, aquatic center operations, policing policy updates due to Covid-19, etc.

**Shrewsbury Municipal Court Update**

Judge Gentry Smith then provided a brief overview of the municipal court operations, and how those had been impacted due to the pandemic. The board thanked the judge for the update.

**Preparatory Budget Committee Work for 2021**

The Mayor then provided a brief update regarding the committee budget work that would commence between himself, Director Oettle, and Aldermen Lauter and Peters in preparation for the 2021 budget season.

**June 2 General Municipal Election**

Director Greever then provided a quick update on the issues and candidates on the ballot for the general municipal election, which would be held the following Tuesday, June 2.

**Old/New Business**

The Board members thanked Alderman Gorman for her years of service.


**Closed Session**


**Adjournment**
