Mayor Scherer requested a moment of silence in honor of Mrs. Marcia Lauter, mother of Alderman Greg Lauter.

Roll Call

Mayor Scherer opened the meeting and City Clerk Klocke commenced with the roll call. A quorum was present for the transaction of city business.

Approval of Minutes

Mayor Scherer introduced the minutes from the August 2019 Work Session and opened the floor for discussion. There being no discussion, Alderman Travaglini made a motion to approve the minutes; Alderman Gorman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Approval of Bills

Mayor Scherer reviewed the bills submitted for payment which totaled \$43,759.47. The Mayor called for a motion to approve the bills for payment. Alderman Lauter made the motion; Alderman Gorman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Hear Citizens

Mr. Garen Miller, 5115 St. Charles Place, reported that the annual triathlon was a success. Mr. Miller thanked the Parks and Recreation Department for their logistical support. Mr. Miller

expressed appreciation for the assistance offered by the Shrewsbury Police Department. Mr. Miller said plans were under way for the 2020 triathlon.

Mr. Homer Holmes, 7601 Weil Avenue, requested light modifications at the pickleball court in Brinkop Park. Mayor Scherer thanked Mr. Holmes for his request and said City staff will review the request.

Department Head Reports

The Directors of each of the departments present reported on matters of significance in their respective areas.

Ms. Lisa Vargas, Chief of Police, reported on criminal activity on Watson Road and explained that an individual had caused property damage at numerous locations. Chief Vargas said the department was conducting background checks on two candidates for employment. Alderman Travaglini thanked Chief Vargas and her staff for doing a safety check on him following his return from vacation.

Mr. Chris Amenn, Chief of the Fire Department, updated the Board on the Fire Department's progress in hiring a firefighter. Chief Amenn reported on his trip to Pennsylvania to inspect the firetruck that was under construction for the City.

Mr. Tony Wagner, Director of Public Works, reported that the department was cutting grass across the City. Director Wagner said that repairs to the street sweeper were complete, and the equipment was be operational. Director Wagner said the sprinklers in Field 3 of Wehner Park were being repaired.

Mr. Jonathan Greever, Director of Administration, reported on the progress of hiring a Building Commissioner. Director Greever reminded the Board that it will be consider two Special Use Permits at the September Work Session meeting. Director Greever said City staff would meet with residents to discuss the HOAs request of street taking by the City. Director Greever reminded the Board of upcoming meetings and dates to note.

Mayor's Report

Mayor Scherer thanked Director Wagner and Chief Amenn for their work on mechanical fixes to equipment in-house. Mayor Scherer reported on his trip to Pennsylvania to inspect the firetruck that was under construction for the City. Mayor Scherer said that he received many compliments from residents on the walking path lights in Wehner Park.

Adjournment


